God granted your requests - and more! I am excited to announce that 80 new chaplains have been added this year and we have fully met our recruiting goals. Moreover, this success comes three months before the end of our recruiting year! God is gracious indeed.

Our new recruits didn't mystically appear *ex nihilo* in full uniform ready for military service. Our recruiters logged tens of thousands of miles, visited hundreds of seminaries, colleges, and church conferences, sent thousands of e-mails and spent endless hours on the phone being pastors and friends. They distributed informational material by every conceivable means as they searched for the very best candidates. They persevered and did not grow weary in well doing.

In addition, countless Navy Recruiting Command team members worked long, hard hours preparing and mailing literature and ensuring paper work was done properly and on time to support the effort. You, too, came alongside providing leads, referrals and your own time and energy. By laboring together and trusting God's faithfulness we have been blessed with 52 civilians gaining direct commission, 15 reservists being recalled, and 13 CCPOs superceding to active duty service with the Navy Chaplain Corps.
