

**Circuit City is participating in a campaign to send a "Message from America" to the soldiers serving our country overseas? Together with Sony and CBS, and in cooperation with the Department of Defense, Circuit City has extended an invitation for people to come to their stores to videotape a personal message for the brave men and women defending our freedom. There will be no charge for the service they are providing, and "Message from America" is not linked to any of their sales or promotions. This is Circuit City's way of demonstrating their support for their country. Just imagine what it will mean to the soldiers serving overseas during the holidays to watch DVDs of their children or hear messages of gratitude from total strangers!**

**There are two types of "Message from America" tapes: (1) General messages from anyone who comes into the store and (2) Messages to specific military personnel from people who show valid military IDs. Why military IDs? Because Circuit City has a limited amount of DVD-R media available, and the time involved in burning them does not allow them to provide a free DVD to every person with a contact in the military service. The intent was to make sure those closest to our military men and women were able to take advantage of the DVD service. In the course of the campaign, people without military ID may request a specific message on DVD to a specific person.**

**Your message will be sent along with thousands of others from around the country to both CBS and the Armed Forces Network. They will then edit and share as many messages as possible with our troops stationed around the world. Some messages will also be selected by CBS to be aired here in the US.**
